

ELLIE Net Web Notice:

Currently the ELLIE Net system allows for Industry users to find and track their paper applications, such as General Correspondence (GC) Letters and Applications for Permanent/Temporary Export or Temporary Import of Classified Defense Articles and Related Classified Technical Data (DSP-85). As part of DDTC's modernization effort, ELLIE Net will be decommissioned and Industry users will no longer be able to access ELLIE Net.

Before DDTC's modernization effort goes into effect, DDTC recommends Industry begin including valid email addresses on all paper applications so DDTC can send you an email with your application number. DDTC will use this transition period to work out any problems with the interim process.

How will I receive my paper application (GCs and DSP-85s) number?

Beginning immediately, please provide a valid email address on all of your paper applications so we can send you an email with your case number.

- GC Letters – clearly state the email address to receive your case number in your GC letter.
- DSP-85s – clearly state the email address to receive your case number in either your letter of explanation (preferred) or in the Specific Purpose, Block 21 (if no letter is sent).

The email address provided to DDTC will be used to provide you with your application number from an unmonitored automated email system. You will receive your case number once it becomes available in DDTC's case management system (Note: this may take up to two-weeks due to Department of State mail room processing time, weather delays, holidays, etc).

Once you have received your case number, you will be able to track the case status via the ELISA (<http://elisa.dtsa.mil/>) application.
