Dear Mr. Speaker:

Pursuant to Section 36(c) and (d) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of a proposed manufacturing license agreement for the manufacture of significant military equipment abroad and the export of defense articles or defense services in the amount of \$100,000,000 or more.

The transaction contained in the attached certification involves the export to the United Kingdom of technical data, defense services and hardware for the manufacture of the MPR-9600 and RF-5800H-MP HF tactical radio systems for resale to Albania, Bolivia, Brazil, Brunei, Bulgaria, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Egypt, Ghana, Guatemala, Hungary, Iraq, Jamaica, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Malawi, Malaysia, Morocco, Mozambique, Netherlands, Nigeria, Oman, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Spain, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, Tanzania, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, Uganda, and U.S.

The United States Government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
