Pursuant to Section 36(d) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of a proposed manufacturing license agreement for the manufacture of significant military equipment abroad.

The transaction contained in the attached certification involves the export of technical data and defense services to Turkey for the manufacture and repair of the upgradeable AN/APX-117 Transponder. This transaction also supports integration of the AN/APX-117 Transponder, the AN/UPX-37 Digital Interrogator, the AN/APX-113 Combined Interrogator/ Transponder and associated special test equipment, and the Man-Portable Digital Interrogator on various Turkish Ministry of Defense military platforms.

The United States Government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
