Dear Mr. President:

Pursuant to Section 36(d) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of a proposed manufacturing license agreement for the production of significant military equipment in Canada.

The transaction contained in the attached certification involves the export of defense articles, including technical data, and defense services for the manufacture of the APS-508 Radar to support the Canadian CP-140 Maritime Patrol Aircraft for end use by the Canadian Department of National Defence.

The United States government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights, and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
