Dear Mr. Speaker:

Pursuant to Section 36(d) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of a proposed manufacturing license agreement for the manufacture of significant military equipment abroad.

The transaction contained in the attached certification involves the transfer of defense articles, to include technical data, and defense services, to India for the manufacture, assembly, integration, testing and repair of the Enhanced Position Location Reporting System Extended Frequency-International (EPLRS-XF-I), MicroLight-I and MicroLight-DH500 and ancillary equipment in India for delivery to and end-use by the Indian Ministry of Defense (MOD) and its subordinate military commands.

The United States Government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
