Dear Mr. Speaker:

Pursuant to Section 36(d) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of a proposed amendment to a manufacturing license agreement for the manufacture of significant military equipment abroad.

The transaction contained in the attached certification involves the export of defense articles, including technical data, and defense services to the United Kingdom and Australia to support the manufacture of an integrated network to be used for command and control functionality to support military and civil defense applications for chemical, biological, explosive, and radiological detection equipment. These components will be exported to the United Kingdom to support manufacturing of an end-item abroad to be known as SensaLinx or Project Bridge.

The United States government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights, and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
