Pursuant to Section 36(c) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of a proposed license for the export of defense articles, including technical data, or defense services abroad in the amount of \$100,000,000 or more.

The transaction contained in the attached certification provides F-15K maintenance and support to include associated spare parts, support equipment, and technical support to the Republic of Korea.

The United States government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
