Dear Mr. President:

Pursuant to Section 36(c) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of a proposed permanent export of defense articles, including technical data, and defense services in the amount of \$1,000,000 or more.

The transaction contained in the attached certification involves the export of defense articles to the Philippine National Police, Quezon City, Republic of the Philippines for the export of 59,904 Glock Model 17 GEN4, 9mm semi-automatic pistols, and associated parts and components. These defense articles are for the exclusive use by the officers of the Philippines National Police to further protect their citizens.

The United States government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights, and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
